AN ACT

To appropriate money for supplemental purposes for the several departments and offices of state government, and for purchase of equipment, and for the payment of various claims for refunds, for persons, firms, and corporations, and for other purposes, and to transfer money among certain funds, from the funds designated for the fiscal period ending June 30, 2008.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

There is appropriated out of the State Treasury, chargeable to the fund and for the agency

8 opportunity to have those MO HealthNet dollars follow them to
9 the community to the extent necessary to meet their unmet needs
10 as determined by 19 CSR 30 81.030 and further be allowed to
11 choose the personal care program option in the community that
12 best meets the individuals' unmet needs. This includes the
13 Consumer Directed MO HealthNet State Plan. And further
14 provided that individuals eligible for the MO HealthNet Personal
15 Care Option must be allowed to choose, from among all the
16 program options, that option which best meets their unmet needs
17 as determined by 19 CSR 30 81.030; and also be allowed to have
18 their MO HealthNet funds follow them to the extent necessary to
19 meet their unmet needs whichever option they choose. This
20 language does not create any entitlements not established by

21 statute. Upon receipt of a referral for MO HealthNet funded home
 22 and community-based care containing a nurse assessment or
 23 physician's order, the department shall review the
 24 recommendations regarding services and process the referral
 25 within 15 business days. When information contained in the
 26 referral is sufficient to establish eligibility for MO HealthNet
 27 funded long-term care and determine the level of service need as
 28 required pursuant to state and federal regulations, the department
 29 shall prior-authorize Home and Community-based services and
 30 arrange for the provision of services. MO HealthNet
 31 reimbursement for personal care benefits shall be effective the date
 32 of the assessment or physician's order. MO HealthNet
 33 reimbursement for Waiver services shall be effective the date the
 34 state develops and approves the care plan. At such time the state
 35 shall notify the referring entity. The in-home provider shall be
 36 reimbursed a minimum of one and no more than two authorized
 37 nurse visits to make the initial nurse assessment. When
 38 information is insufficient or the proposed care plan requires
 39 additional evaluation by state staff that is not obtainable from the
 40 referring entity, the department shall inform the provider and
 41 contact the individual to schedule an in-home assessment to be
 42 conducted by the state staff within 30 days
