AN ACT

To repeal section 67.306, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to ticket scalping, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 67.306, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 578.395, to read as follows:

578.395. 1. Any person, firm, or corporation who resells or offers to resell any ticket for admission, or any other evidence of the right of entry, to any public sporting 2 event for a price in excess of the price printed on the ticket is guilty of the offense of ticket 3 scalping. For purposes of this section, if a seller requires, as a precondition of the resale 4 5 of a ticket, the purchase or rental of other goods or services at a price in excess of the fair market value of such goods or services, the excess amount shall be deemed to be part of the 6 purchase price of the ticket. 7 8 2. Nothing in this section shall prohibit nor shall be deemed to prohibit a seller, 9 with consent of the sponsor of such sporting event, from collecting a reasonable service charge from a ticket purchaser in return for services actually rendered. 10

3. Any person violating this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a
misdemeanor and, except as provided in subsection 4 of this section, shall be punished as
follows:

(1) For the first offense, by a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than three
 hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not less than fifteen
 days;

(2) For the second offense, by a fine of not less than three hundred dollars nor more
than five hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term of not less than
sixty days nor more than six months;

(3) For the third and each subsequent offense, by a fine of not less than five
hundred dollars nor more than one thousand dollars or imprisonment in the county jail
for a term of not less than six months nor more than one year.

4. In lieu of any fine imposed under subsection 3 of this section, the court may
invoke the provisions of subsection 2 of section 560.016, RSMo, against any person
convicted of a second or subsequent offense of this section.

[67.306. No regulation or ordinance of any city, county, or other political subdivision shall prohibit the sale or resale of an admission ticket to any legal event at any price or prohibit the charging of any fee in connection with such sale or resale except that nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent the enforcement of any regulation or ordinance relating to criminal activity, consumer fraud, false advertising, or other deceptive business practices.]
