AN ACT

To amend chapter 565, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to prohibiting the creation of mixed human-animal individuals, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 565, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 565.325, to read as follows:

565.325. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

- 2 (1) "Human chimera", any of the following:
 - (a) A human embryo into which a nonhuman cell or cells, or the component parts thereof, have been introduced that render its membership in the species homo sapiens uncertain through germline or other changes;
- (b) A hybrid human/animal embryo produced by fertilizing a human egg with a 7 nonhuman sperm;
- (c) A hybrid human/animal embryo produced by fertilizing a nonhuman egg with 8 human sperm;
- 10 (d) An embryo produced by introducing a nonhuman cell nucleus into a human 11 egg;
- 12 (e) An embryo produced by introducing a human nucleus into a nonhuman egg;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

13 (f) An embryo containing haploid sets of chromosomes from both a human and a 14 nonhuman life form;

- 15 (g) A nonhuman life form engineered such that human gametes develop within the 16 body of a nonhuman life form; or
 - (h) A nonhuman life form engineered such that it contains a human brain or a brain derived wholly or predominantly from human neural tissues;
- 19 **(2)** "Human embryo", an organism of the species *homo sapiens* during the early 20 stages of development, from one cell forward.
 - 2. No person shall knowingly perform any of the following acts:
- 22 (1) Create or attempt to create a human chimera;
- 23 (2) Transfer or attempt to transfer a human embryo into a nonhuman womb;
- 24 (3) Transfer or attempt to transfer a nonhuman embryo into a human womb; or
 - (4) Transport or receive for any purpose a human chimera.
- 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of a class D felony.
- 27 Any person who violates the provisions of this section and derives pecuniary gain from
- 28 such violation shall be subject to a civil fine of the greater of one million dollars or an
- 29 amount equal to three times the amount of the gross gain resulting from such violation.
