## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 407, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to residential construction disclosure forms.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 407, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 407.1950, to read as follows:

- 407.1950. 1. Beginning on or after August 28, 2008, before any residential home
- 2 repair or remodeling contract for a preexisting property is executed, the contractor shall
- $3\quad \textbf{deliver to the owner a disclosure form containing information regarding the contractor and}$
- 4 the contractor's work history. Such form shall include the signature of the contractor
- 5 verifying the information contained in the disclosure form is true and accurate. The
- 6 disclosure form shall be signed by the owner indicating the owner is adequately informed
- 7 about the contractor and the contractor's work history.
- 8 2. The disclosure form shall contain the following information:
- 9 (1) Name of the contractor;
  - (2) Whether the contractor is licensed and where the contractor is licensed;
- 11 (3) Whether there has been a court judgment against the contractor within the last
- 12 five years, and if so, the nature of the judgment;
- 13 (4) Whether the name of the company the contractor works for has changed within 14 the last five years;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

15 (5) Whether the contractor is registered within the state of Missouri, and if so,

- 16 where the contractor is registered; and
- 17 (6) How long the contractor has been conducting business.
- 3. The attorney general shall create the disclosure form described in this section.
- 19 Such form shall be made available through the attorney general's Internet web site.
