AN ACT

To repeal section 376.1753, RSMo, relating to the practice of midwifery.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 376.1753, RSMo, is repealed, to be known as section 376.1753, to
2 read as follows:

2 [376.1753. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, any person who
3 holds current ministerial or tocological certification by an organization accredited
3 by the National Organization for Competency Assurance (NOCA) may provide
4 services as defined in 42 U.S.C. 1396 r-6(b)(4)(E)(ii)(I).]
