## AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the fencing of conservation lands.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 252.048, to read as follows:

**252.048. The department of conservation shall enclose any of its lands which are**  
2 **in excess of six hundred forty acres with fencing that is sufficient in design and materials**  
3 **to prevent, to the reasonable and feasible extent possible, the ingress and egress of deer in**  
4 **the enclosed lands through or over such fencing.**
