## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 190.308, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to misuse of emergency telephone service, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 190.308, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 190.308, to read as follows:

190.308. 1. In any county that has established an emergency telephone service pursuant 2 to sections 190.300 to 190.320, it shall be unlawful for any person to misuse the emergency 3 telephone service. For the purposes of this section, "emergency" means any incident involving 4 danger to life or property that calls for an emergency response dispatch of police, fire, EMS or other public safety organization, "misuse the emergency telephone service", includes, but is not 5 limited to, repeatedly calling the "911" for nonemergency situations causing operators or 6 equipment to be in use when emergency situations may need such operators or equipment and 7 8 "repeatedly" means three or more times within a one-month period. 9

2. Any violation of this section is a class B misdemeanor.

3. No political subdivision shall impose any fine or penalty on the owner of a pay 10

telephone or on the owner of any property upon which a pay telephone is located for calls 11

12 to the emergency telephone service made from the pay telephone. Any such fine or penalty

13 is hereby void.
