ANACT

To amend chapter 67, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to political activities of emergency personnel.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 67, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 67.180, to read as follows:

- 67.180. 1. No political subdivision shall prohibit any emergency personnel as defined in section 565.081, RSMo, from the following activities:
- 3 (1) Becoming or continuing to be members of any political party, club, or 4 organization;
 - (2) Attending political meetings;
 - (3) Expressing views in private on political matters outside working hours and off political subdivision premises;
 - (4) Voting with complete freedom in any election;
- 9 (5) Being a candidate for or serving in elective or appointed office in any political subdivision that does not have jurisdiction over or provide services to such emergency personnel's place of residence.
- 2. A political subdivision may prohibit emergency personnel from engaging in any activity listed in subsection 1 of this section while in uniform or on duty, and may prohibit such emergency personnel from soliciting votes, campaigning for funds, or challenging
