11 **Whereas**, in view of Taiwan's aspiration and capability to join in the global efforts 12 to eliminate epidemic diseases and to increase the awareness of protecting the environment and 13 maintaining a sustainable development of this planet, Taiwan should be accorded access to 14 certain international organizations, such as the United Nations and World Health Organization, 15 to facilitate its contribution to the global efforts:
