2 **Whereas**, Missouri is pleased to be home to the six-state regional Taipei Economic
and Cultural Office in Kansas City; and

4 **Whereas**, Missouri has demonstrated its commitment to trade with Taiwan by
5 maintaining a Trade Office in Taipei since 1990; and

7 **Whereas**, the people of the State of Missouri recognize the economic achievements
8 and democratic progression of Taiwan and extend a hand of friendship to its citizens in honor
9 of their contributions to our economy; and

11 **Whereas**, in view of Taiwan's aspiration and capability to join in the global efforts
12 to eliminate epidemic diseases and to increase the awareness of protecting the environment and
13 maintaining a sustainable development of this planet, Taiwan should be accorded access to
14 certain international organizations, such as the United Nations and World Health Organization,
15 to facilitate its contribution to the global efforts:

17 **Now, therefore, be it resolved** that the members of the House of
18 Representatives of the Ninety-fourth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate
19 concurring therein, hereby support Taiwan in its efforts to play a constructive role in the
20 International Community; and

22 **Be it further resolved** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
23 Representatives be instructed to prepare properly inscribed copies of this resolution for the
24 United States Secretary of State, the Taipei Economic Cultural Office in Kansas City, and each
25 member of the Missouri Congressional delegation.
