### AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to automated photo red light enforcement systems, with a penalty provision.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 304.825, to read as follows:

304.825. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, including but not  
2 limited to sections 304.271, 304.281, 304.367, and 304.570, any person who commits a  
3 steady red light violation that is detected and enforced through an automated photo red  
4 light enforcement system is guilty of an infraction. A penalty imposed by an agency for a  
5 violation detected pursuant to a system shall not be deemed a moving violation and shall  
6 not be made part of the operation record of the person upon whom such liability is  
7 imposed, nor shall such imposition of a penalty be subject to merit rating for insurance  
8 purposes and no surcharge points shall be imposed in the provision of motor vehicle  
9 insurance coverage. In no case shall points be assessed against any person under section  
10 302.302, RSMo, for a violation detected by an automated photo red light enforcement  
11 system.
