AN ACT

To amend chapter 316, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the regulation of swimming pools, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 316, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 316.255, to read as follows:

316.255. 1. As used in this section, the following terms mean:

2 (1) "Certified operator", an individual who has successfully completed the 3 Certified Pool-Spa Operator course approved by the National Swimming Pool Foundation, 4 the Aquatic Facility Operator course approved by the National Recreation and Park Association, or an equivalent course provided by a nonprofit organization approved by the 5 department of health and senior services. Such course shall provide at least fourteen hours 6 of training on pool operation, safety, and maintenance. At least six hours of training and 7 a proctored exam shall be carried out in a classroom environment. The remainder of the 8 9 training may be carried out by online training approved by the department. A copy of the certification shall be forwarded to the department. A certified operator shall maintain his 10 or her certification as required by the applicable organization; 11 12 (2) "Swimming pool", a fixed or mobile structure, basin, chamber, or tank and 13 appurtenant buildings and equipment that serve or are installed for use by: 14 (a) The state; 15 (b) A political subdivision of the state;

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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16	(c) A motel or hotel;
17	(d) A resort, camp, club, or association;
18	(e) A housing development;
19	(f) A school;
20	(g) A religious, charitable, or youth organization;
21	(h) An educational or rehabilitation facility; or
22	(i) Another entity.

24	Swimming pool does not include a fixed or mobile structure, basin, chamber, or tank that
25	only serves three or fewer individual residences.
26	2. Beginning July 1, 2009, an owner of a swimming pool shall employ at least one
27	certified operator. The owner shall replace a vacancy in the certified operator position
28	within ninety days of the occurrence of the vacancy if the owner employs only one certified
29	operator. A current certificate of a certified operator by an owner of a swimming pool

30 shall be posted conspicuously and maintained at the swimming pool for the duration of

- 31 such employment.
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3. Any person who violates the provisions of this section is guilty of an infraction.

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
