AN ACT

To amend chapter 571, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to waiver of a NICS background check for certain persons purchasing firearms.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 571, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 571.124, to read as follows:

**571.124. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all federally licensed firearms
2 dealers shall waive the requirement of a NICS background check for any person seeking
3 to purchase a firearm who possesses a valid concealed carry endorsement issued under the
4 provisions of this chapter.**
