AN ACT

To amend chapter 168, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school superintendents.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 168, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 168.218, to read as follows:

**168.218. 1. Two or more adjacent school districts may share a superintendent who
2 possesses a valid Missouri superintendent's license when at least one of the sharing districts
3 is classified as accredited or provisionally accredited by the state board of education.**

**4 2. The department of elementary and secondary education may issue rules or
5 regulations to carry out the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that
6 term is defined in section 536.010, RSMo, that is created under the authority delegated in
7 this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the
8 provisions of chapter 536, RSMo, and, if applicable, section 536.028, RSMo. This section
9 and chapter 536, RSMo, are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general
10 assembly pursuant to chapter 536, RSMo, to review, to delay the effective date, or to
11 disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of
12 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2008, shall be
13 invalid and void.**
