## AN ACT

To amend chapter 394, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to electric cooperatives.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 394, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 394.320, to read as follows:

394.320. 1. Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, any regional electric cooperative providing services to two or more municipalities of any classification that is 2 3 located in whole or in part within the state of Missouri and that has the primary function of generating and transmitting power from a generation cooperative to a distribution 4 cooperative shall allow the municipalities to whom it provides services to appoint at least 5 two members to the governing board of such regional electric cooperative. 6 The 7 appointments shall be made by a majority vote of the mayors of the municipalities served 8 by the regional electric cooperative. Those appointed to the governing board of the regional electric cooperative shall enjoy the full rights, privileges, and benefits of the other 9 members of the board of the regional electric cooperative. 10 2. This section may be enforced in any court of proper jurisdiction by an injunctive
