AN ACT

To amend chapter 393, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public utilities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 393, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 393.152, to read as follows:

**393.152. 1. A public utility may require a deposit or other guarantee as a condition
2 of new residential service only if:**

3 **(1) The customer has in an unauthorized manner interfered with or diverted the
4 service of a utility providing the same service situated on or about or delivered to the
5 customer's premises within the last five years; or**

6 **(2) The customer is unable to establish an acceptable credit rating under standards
7 contained in tariffs filed with and approved by the commission. The customer shall be
8 deemed prima facie to have established an acceptable credit rating if the customer meets
9 any of the following criteria:**

10 **(a) Owns or is purchasing a home;**

11 **(b) Is and has been regularly employed on a full-time basis for at least one year;**

12 **(c) Has an adequate regular source of income; or**

13 **(d) Can provide adequate credit references from a commercial credit source.**

14 **2. A public utility may require a deposit or guarantee as a condition of continued
15 residential service only if:**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended
to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

16 (1) The service of the customer has been discontinued by the public utility for
17 nonpayment of a delinquent account not in dispute; or

18 (2) In an unauthorized manner, the customer interfered with or diverted the service
19 of the utility situated on or about or delivered to the customer's premises.

20 3. A deposit or other guarantee shall not be required if the customer has
21 consistently paid a portion of his or her utility service bill each month and has an
22 undisputed arrearage of five hundred dollars or less.
