

HB 1638 -- Pornographic Material

This bill expands the crime of furnishing pornographic material to a minor to include when the offender believes that the person to whom the material is furnished is a minor; that any person viewing a pornographic performance is a minor; or that any person who participates in or makes available pornographic material via computer, electronic transfer, Internet, or computer network is a minor.

The penalty for the crime of furnishing pornographic material to minors is increased from a class A misdemeanor to a class D felony unless the person has previously pled guilty to or been found guilty of a sexual or pornographic offense in which case the penalty is increased from a class D felony to a class C felony.
