

HCS HB 1649 -- DRIVER'S LICENSES OF REGISTERED SEXUAL OFFENDERS  
(Franz)

This substitute specifies that the driver's or nondriver's license of a registered sexual offender will expire after one year unless the license is issued for a shorter period of time due to other requirements of law. A license will be revoked if the offender fails to register as required by law.

The driver's or nondriver's license of a sexual offender must prominently display a unique code or identifier. The fee for the one-year license will be \$7.50.

The State Highway Patrol must provide a list which includes the full name, address, and Social Security number of registered sexual offenders to the Department of Revenue.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on General Revenue Fund in FY 2009, FY 2010, and FY 2011. Estimated Income on Other State Funds of will not exceed \$75,000 in FY 2009, FY 2010, and FY 2011.
