HB 1930 -- Court Costs

Sponsor: Cooper (120)

This bill authorizes circuit courts to collect a \$4 fee on all cases filed on or after September 1, 2008, for deposit into the circuit clerk's record preservation fund to be used for record storage, microfilming, preservation, and public access of circuit court records. The bill also specifies that no fee authorized by Sections 488.010 - 488.020, RSMo, can be collected in any proceeding involving a violation of an ordinance or state law when a criminal case has been dismissed by the court or when the costs are waived or paid by the state, county, or municipality.
