FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **City of Waynesville** stated the proposal could generate roughly \$60,000 per year and be used to build a 100 room hotel and convention center.

Officials from **Pulaski County** did not respond to our request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes this proposal, as written, does not mandate that the City of Waynesville impose a transient guest tax for the purpose of funding the construction of and the maintenance of a multipurpose conference and convention center. Oversight assumes this proposal is permissive and that the fiscal impact would not be realized without action by the governing body and voter approval. Oversight will show fiscal impact as zero.
