ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** and **Clinton County** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Platte County Board of Election Commission** assume a cost of \$300 per year.

No other board of election commission or local election authority responded to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

Oversight assumes that the local election authorities already must provide for federal service employees voting in the presidential election and therefore, expanding the voting to all elections could incur minor costs that could be absorbed with existing resources.
