## FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

Small businesses could see a positive fiscal impact from reduced telecommunications rates.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This proposed legislation states that a composite interstate exchange access rate imposed by a local exchange network shall be reduced annually for three years by an amount equal to five percent for each year. Such reduction shall be in addition to any rate rebalancing efforts by a price cap company.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
