AN ACT

To repeal section 578.255, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to alcohol beverage vaporizers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 578.255, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 578.255, to read as follows:

578.255. 1. As used in this section, "alcohol beverage vaporizer" means any device 2 which, by means of heat, a vibrating element, or any other method, is capable of producing a breathable mixture containing one or more alcoholic beverages to be dispensed for 3

inhalation into the lungs via the nose or mouth or both. 4

5 2. No person shall intentionally or willfully induce the symptoms of intoxication, elation, euphoria, dizziness, excitement, irrational behavior, exhilaration, paralysis, stupefaction, or 6 7 dulling of the senses or nervous system, distortion of audio, visual or mental processes by the 8 use of any [solvent, particularly toluol] of the following substances:

- 9 (1) Solvents, particularly toluol; or
- 10 (2) Ethyl alcohol.

3. This section shall not apply to substances that have been approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration as therapeutic drug products or are contained in 12

13 approved over-the-counter drug products or administered lawfully pursuant to the order

- 14 of an authorized medical practitioner.
- 15 [2.] 4. No person shall intentionally possess any solvent, particularly toluol, for the purpose of using it in the manner prohibited by section 578.250 and this section. 16
- 17 5. No person shall possess or use an alcoholic beverage vaporizer.

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

18 6. Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the legal consumption of

intoxicating liquor, as defined by section 311.020, RSMo, or nonintoxicating beer, asdefined by section 312.010, RSMo.
