## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 565, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to assaulting an athletic official, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 565, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 565.079, to read as follows:

565.079. 1. A person commits the crime of assaulting an athletic official if such person, without justifiable or excusable cause, and with intent to do bodily harm, commits a misdemeanor assault, as defined in section 565.070, of an athletic official in connection with an athletic event.

- 2. As used in this section "athletic official" includes any referee, umpire, timekeeper, coach, or other official having authority in connection with any amateur or professional athletic event.
- 8 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 565.070, assaulting an athletic official 9 is a class A misdemeanor.
