1 AMEND House Joint Resolution No. 0076, Page 1, Line 4 in the title, by deleting said line and  
2 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

3 “initiative proposals.”; and

5 Further amend said resolution, Page 1, Section 44, Line 7, by inserting after all of said line the  
6 following:

7 “Section 2(b). 1. All amendments proposed by the general assembly or by the initiative  
8 shall be submitted to the electors for their approval or rejection by official ballot title as may be  
9 provided by law, on a separate ballot without party designation, at the next general election, or at a  
10 special election called by the governor prior thereto, at which he may submit any of the  
11 amendments. No such proposed amendment shall contain more than one amended and revised  
12 article of this constitution, or one new article which shall not contain more than one subject and  
13 matters properly connected therewith. If possible, each proposed amendment shall be published  
14 once a week for two consecutive weeks in two newspapers of different political faith in each  
15 county, the last publication to be not more than thirty nor less than fifteen days next preceding the  
16 election. If there be but one newspaper in any county, publication for four consecutive weeks  
17 shall be made. If a majority of the votes cast thereon is in favor of any amendment, the same shall  
18 take effect at the end of thirty days after the election. More than one amendment at the same  
19 election shall be so submitted as to enable the electors to vote on each amendment separately.

20 2. No initiative proposal shall take effect unless approved by a four-sevenths majority of  
21 the votes cast thereon.”; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
