1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for Senate Bill No. 808, Page 1,
2 Section A, Line 4, by inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "34.074. 1. As used in this section, the term "service-disabled veteran" means any individual
5 who is disabled as certified by the appropriate federal agency responsible for the administration of
6 veterans' affairs.

7 2. As used in this section, the term "service-disabled veteran business" means a business concern:

8 (1) Not less than fifty-one percent of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or,
9 in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than fifty-one percent of the stock of which is owned
10 by one or more service-disabled veterans; and

11 (2) The management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more
12 service-disabled veterans.

13 3. In letting contracts for the performance of any job or service, all agencies, departments,
14 institutions, and other entities of this state and of each political subdivision of this state shall give a three-
15 point bonus preference to service-disabled veteran businesses doing business as Missouri firms,
16 corporations, or individuals, or which maintain Missouri offices or places of business[, when the quality
17 of performance promised is equal or better and the price quoted is the same or less. The commissioner of
18 administration may also give such preference whenever competing bids, in their entirety, are comparable].

19 4. In implementing the provisions of subsection 3 of this section, the following shall apply:

20 (1) The commissioner of administration shall have the goal of three percent of all such contracts
21 described in subsection 3 of this section to be let to such veterans;

22 (2) If no or an insufficient number of such veterans doing business in this state [meet the quality
23 of performance and price standards required in subsection 3 of this section] submit a bid or proposal for a
24 contract let by an agency, department, institution, or other entity of the state or a political subdivision,
25 such [preference] goal shall not be required and the provisions of subdivision (1) of this subsection shall
26 not apply.";and

28 Further amend said bill, Page 24, Section B, Line 6, by inserting after all of said line the following:

29 "Section C. The emergency clause contained in Section B of this act shall not apply to section
30 34.074 of Section A of this act."; and

32 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
33 accordingly.
