The petition shall set forth:	
(1) A description of the	e territory to be embraced in the proposed district;
(2) The names of the n	nunicipalities located within the area;

(4) The population of t	the district which shall not be less than two thousand inhabitants;
(5) The assessed valua	tion of the area, which shall not be less than ten million dollars; a
(6) A request that the c	question be submitted to the voters residing within the limits of the
proposed ambulance district w	hether they will establish an ambulance district pursuant to the
provisions of sections 190.001	to 190.090 to be known as " Ambulance District" for the
purpose of establishing and ma	intaining an ambulance service.
2. In any county with a	charter form of government and with more than one million
inhabitants, fire protection dist	ricts created under chapter 321, RSMo, may choose to create an
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1	ambulance district with boundaries congruent with each participating fire protection district's
2	existing boundaries provided no ambulance district already exists in whole or part of any district
3	being proposed and the dominant provider of ambulance services within the proposed district as
4	of September 1, 2005, ceases to offer or provide ambulance services, and the board of each
5	participating district, by a majority vote, approves the formation of such a district and
6	participating fire protection districts are contiguous. Upon approval by the fire protection district
7	boards, subsection 1 of this section shall be followed for formation of the ambulance district.
8	Services provided by a district under this subsection shall only include emergency ambulance
9	services as defined in section 321.225, RSMo.
10	3. Any ambulance district established under this chapter on or after August 28, 2010, may
11	levy and impose a sales tax in lieu of a property tax to fund the ambulance district. The petition to
12	create the ambulance district shall state whether the district will be funded by a property or a sales
13	<u>tax.</u>
