1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute
 2 for Senate Bill No. 829, Page 37, Section 621.275, Line 21, by
 3 inserting after all of said line the following:

4 "650.130. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited
 5 as "The Kelsey Smith Act".

6 2. Upon request of a law enforcement agency, a wireless
 7 telecommunications carrier shall provide call location
 8 information concerning the telecommunications device of the user
 9 to the requesting law enforcement agency in order to respond to a
 10 call for emergency services or in an emergency situation that
 11 involves the risk of death or serious physical harm.

12 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, nothing in
 13 this section prohibits a wireless telecommunications carrier from
 14 establishing protocols by which the carrier could voluntarily
 15 disclose call location information.

16 4. No cause of action shall lie in any court against any
 17 wireless telecommunications carrier, its officers, employees,
 18 agents or other specified persons for providing call location
 19 information while acting in good faith and in accordance with the
 20 provisions of this section.

21 5. All wireless telecommunications carriers registered to
 22 do business in the state of Missouri or submitting to the
 23 jurisdiction thereof and all resellers of wireless
 24 telecommunications services shall submit their emergency contact
 25 information to the department of public safety in order to
 26 facilitate requests from a law enforcement agency for call
 27 location information in accordance with this section. This
 28 contact information shall be submitted annually by June fifteenth
 29 or immediately upon any change in contact information.

1 6. The department of public safety shall maintain a
2 database containing emergency contact information for all
3 wireless telecommunications carriers registered to do business in
4 the state of Missouri and shall make the information immediately
5 available upon request to all public safety answer points in the
6 state.

7 7. The director of the department of public safety shall
8 promulgate any rules and regulations necessary to fulfill the
9 requirements of this section no later than July 1, 2011."; and

10 Further amend said title, enacting clause and intersectional
11 references accordingly.
