#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State**, **Platte County Board of Election Commission** and the **Monroe County** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Officials at the **Cass County** assume a savings from not having elections of \$1,000 to Unknown per each election not held.

Officials at the **Kansas City Board of Election Commission** assume based on historical data with Municipal elections in their jurisdiction, they see no fiscal impact on their operations. However, if candidate participation decreases, there could be a substantial savings in polling place rental, judge expense, legal notices and printing costs.

Officials at the **St. Louis County Board of Election Commission** assume there would be a positive impact that would alleviate costs associated with ballot and election preparation and also the operating costs associated with running the polls. However, due to the variance of the number of elections that would not be held it is unknown what the savings would be.

No other Local Election Authority responded to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact. Oversight assumes that any elections not held would be a savings to the Local Election Authorities. **Oversight** has shown an Unknown savings to Local Election Authorities.

#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

#### FISCAL DESCRIPTION

Currently, in a nonpartisan election in any political subdivision or special district with the exception of municipal elections, candidates are allowed to take office without an election if the number of candidates is equal to the number of positions to be filled and proper notice has been published in at least one newspaper of general circulation in the district. This bill removes the exception for municipal elections.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
