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#### **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development** as well as the **Department of Public Safety - Missouri Veterans' Commission** and **Office of the Adjutant General** each assume the proposal would not fiscally impact their respective agencies.

The appropriation for the Hero at Home program is \$315,000 in FY 2010 and was \$350,000 in FY 2009. According to the Yearly Fund Activity Reports from the **Office of the State Treasurer**, the Guard at Home Fund had disbursements of \$18,810.02 in FY 2008 and \$11,296.47 in FY 2009.

**Oversight** assumes the Department of Economic Development will still be able to operate the program within existing appropriations with the proposed changes.
