## FISCAL ANALYSIS

### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development - Public Service Commission** and **Office of Public Counsel** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective divisions.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety - Office of the Director, Missouri State Highway Patrol**, and the **Missouri Water Patrol** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies. In response to an identical proposal from last session (HB 736 - FN 1865-04), officials from the **Capitol Police** and the **Division of Fire Safety** stated this proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Springfield Police Department** and the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective departments.

Officials from the **Columbia Police Department** assume this proposed legislation is not applicable to their department, since their department does not dispatch calls.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


### FISCAL DESCRIPTION
