#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Office of Administration – Administrative Hearing Commission,
Department of Economic Development, Department of Elementary and Secondary
Education, Department of Transportation, Department of Revenue, Office of the
Governor, Department of Conservation, State Auditor's Office, State Tax Commission,
City of Centralia, Cass County, St. Louis County, and the Little Blue Valley Sewer District
assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources. If there is a significant increase in complaints relating to violations, AGO may seek additional appropriations to cover the increase.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** assume many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this proposal for Administrative Rules is less than \$2,500. The SOS recognizes this is a small amount and does not expect additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the SOS can sustain with their core budget. Any additional required funding would be handled through the budget process.

Officials from Bi-State Development, Various Missouri Public School Districts, Various Missouri Cities, Various Missouri Counties, and Various Public Utilities did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.
