### FISCAL ANALYSIS

#### ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Economic Development, Department of Elementary and** Secondary Education, Department of Transportation, Department of Revenue, Office of the Governor, Department of Conservation, Office of the State Auditor, Office of the Secretary of State, State Tax Commission, City of Centralia, Linn State Technical College, Metropolitan Community College of Kansas City, Missouri State University, Missouri Southern State University, Northwest Missouri State University, University of Central Missouri, Parkway School District, and the Little Blue Valley Sewer District assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General (AGO)** assume any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources. If there is a significant increase in complaints relating to violations, AGO may seek additional appropriations to cover the increase.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the Office of Administration, Bi-State Development, Various School Districts, Various State Colleges and Universities, Various Missouri Cities, Various Missouri Counties, Various Utilities, and Various Hospitals did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.
