FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Mental Health** and **Department of Health and Senior Services** state this proposed legislation will have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** state this proposed legislation does not appear to have a fiscal impact on their agency. DESE defers to local school districts regarding the potential cost associated with developing, distributing, collecting, and tracking on a yearly basis the concussion and head injury sheets.

Officials from the **Blue Springs** and **Francis Howell School Districts** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective districts.

Officials from the **Special School District of St Louis County** assume this proposed legislation is not expected to have a material fiscal impact on their district. They have a limited number of sports teams at their North Technical High School.

Officials from the **Sikeston School District** indicate they already comply with provisions of this proposal.

Based on responses from school districts, **Oversight** assumes costs to local school districts would be minimal, if any, and could be absorbed with existing resources.
