ASSUMPTION

Governor** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact. **Oversight** assumes there is no fiscal impact from this proposal as the person taking the drug tests must pay the cost of the test.

The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
