FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Social Services, Department of Public Safety – Missouri State Highway Patrol**, and the **Jefferson City Police Department** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Boone County Sheriff's Department** assume they will incur increased costs as a result of the proposal. Officers are going to have to spend additional time investigating a respondent for child care provisions each time the person is contacted. There will also be increased costs of writing new policies and training officers on the new policies.

Oversight assumes local law enforcement agencies could incur increased costs as they would have to check MULES for valid orders of protection which designate child custody or visitation. Oversight assumes any increased costs could be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the Boone County Sheriff's Department, Buchanan County Sheriff's Department, Clark County Sheriff's Department, Columbia Police Department, Independence Police Department, Jackson County Sheriff's Department, Jefferson City Police Department, Kansas City Police Department, Platte County Sheriff's Department, Springfield Police Department, St. Charles Police Department, St. Joseph Police Department, St. Louis County Police Department, and St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department did not respond to Oversight's request for fiscal impact.

The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program, and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
