FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the Office of the State Public Defender, Boone County Sheriff's Department, and the Jefferson City Police Department assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** assume the proposal would have no measurable fiscal impact the Office of Prosecution Services or county prosecutors.

Officials from the **Springfield Police Department** assume the proposal will cause agencies to have backup systems in place and the size of the agency will dictate the cost. Officials estimate the cost of an adequate backup system to be approximately \$5,000

Oversight assumes local law enforcement agencies could absorb any increased costs for backup recording equipment within existing resources.
