FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Office of the Secretary of State** (**SOS**) assume duplication, labels, and cases for 40,000 compacts disks is estimated at \$100,000. Of the 40,000 required compact disks, 23,100 will be delivered to the General Assembly. The remaining 16,900 will be mailed to media outlets, libraries, schools, and constituents as defined in the bill. Postage for the compact disks, including a bulk discount from the postal service, would be \$0.366 each, resulting in \$6,222 for postage. The total expected cost is \$106,222.

Oversight assumes that the provision of this proposal that allows the Secretary of State to charge a fee for all costs of printing of the manual, would not have an impact on state revenue.

Oversight assumes the Secretary of State's FY 2012 proposed budget would have the same amount budgeted for the printing of the state manuals as in FY 2010 of \$500,000. Oversight assumes this proposal is a cost avoidance of \$500,000.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** state many bills considered by the General Assembly include provisions allowing or requiring agencies to submit rules and regulations to implement the act. The SOS is provided with core funding to handle a certain amount of normal activity resulting from each year's legislative session. The fiscal impact for this fiscal note to the SOS for Administrative Rules is less than \$2,500. The SOS recognizes that this is a small amount and does not expect that additional funding would be required to meet these costs. However, the SOS also recognizes that many such bills may be passed by the General Assembly in a given year and that collectively the costs may be in excess of what the office can sustain with the core budget. Therefore, the SOS reserves the right to request funding for the cost of supporting administrative rules requirements should the need arise based on a review of the finally approved bills signed by the governor.

Oversight assumes the SOS could absorb the costs of printing and distributing regulations related to this proposal. If multiple bills pass which require the printing and distribution of regulations at substantial costs, the SOS could request funding through the appropriation process.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION

This bill requires the Official State Manual to be made available for distribution only in an electronic format on compact discs. A printed version of the manual will be available only upon request, and those requesting a printed version will incur a fee necessary to pay for all the costs related to the printing and shipping of the manual.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
