ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Natural Resources** assume there would be no fiscal impact to their agency.

In response to a similar proposal from this session (3289-02, HB 1263), officials from the **Department of Economic Development**, **Public Service Commission**, **Office of Public Counsel**, **St. Louis County**, and the **Public Water Supply District No. 2 of St. Charles County** assumed there would be no fiscal impact to their organizations.

In response to a similar proposal from this session (3289-01), officials from **Little Blue Valley Sewer District** assumed there would be no fiscal impact to their organization.

Officials from **St. Louis Metro Sewer District** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact.

The following counties did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact: **Jackson**, **St. Charles**, and **Jefferson**.
