FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Health and Senior Services (DOH)** state Section 334.1100.7 requires the DOH to provide oversight of compliance with section 334.1100. The DOH currently reviews the qualifications of other healthcare professionals during inspections at hospitals and ambulatory surgical centers. Adding surgical technologists would be an extension of the review already being performed. The review can be completed with existing staff. Therefore, the DOH assumes the proposal will have no fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Bates County Memorial Hospital, Cedar County Memorial Hospital, Cooper County Hospital, Excelsior Springs Medical Center, Putnam County Memorial Hospital, and Washington County Memorial Hospital** did not respond to our request for a statement of fiscal impact.

FISCAL DESCRIPTION


The proposed legislation appears to have no fiscal impact
