FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials at the **Budget and Planning** assume the proposal establishes a Commission on State Expenditures to review and make recommendations concerning state expenditures proposed for appropriations in the state budget. The Commission may request staff of the Office of Administration to assist in the performance of the Commission's duties. Certain levels of assistance could be absorbed within existing resources; however, if OA assumes a comprehensive/primary staffing of the Commission, costs could exceed \$100,000 for additional staff and expense and equipment.

Officials at the **Missouri Senate** assume the members of the Commission are to receive no compensation but may receive actual and necessary expenses. The Senate assumes that the members' expenses would come from funds within the Office of Administration and therefore there would be no impact on the Senate.

Officials at the **Missouri House of Representatives** assume that there is no fiscal impact from this proposal.

Oversight assumes this proposal states that subject to appropriation the Commission may hire staff. Oversight assumes no cost from this proposal, as the Commission will use existing staff for assistance.
