AN ACT

To repeal sections 115.091 and 115.241, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 115.091 and 115.241, RSMo, are repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 77.305, 79.045, and 115.091, to read as follows:

77.305. The city council may submit any question to a vote as an advisory referendum to be included on the ballot for an election to be conducted on a date authorized under section 115.123. Such an advisory referendum, upon receiving a 4 majority of votes in such city, shall only be used by the city council as a measure of public preference and shall not have the force and effect of law. Such questions shall only be submitted in the same manner that questions are otherwise submitted to a vote under chapter 115.

79.045. The city council may submit any question to a vote as an advisory referendum to be included on the ballot for an election to be conducted on a date authorized under section 115.123. Such an advisory referendum, upon receiving a 4 majority of votes in such city, shall only be used by the city council as a measure of public preference and shall not have the force and effect of law. Such questions shall only be submitted in the same manner that questions are otherwise submitted to a vote under chapter 115.

115.091. On commissioning or before entering upon his duties, each election judge shall 2 take and subscribe the following oath:

3 I solemnly swear that I will support and defend the Constitution of the United States 4 and of this state, that I will impartially discharge the duties of judge according to law[,]

9	to the close of the polls on election day.
