AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the reporting of the number of students enrolled in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 160.073, to read as follows:

**160.073. 1. Each public school district, charter school, parochial school, and
2 private school shall provide the following information to the department of elementary and
3 secondary education at the beginning of each school year and at the end of each school
4 year:**

5 **(1) The number of students enrolled;**

6 **(2) The age of each student enrolled at the time of reporting; and**

7 **(3) The number of students in each grade level.**

8 **No school district or school shall provide the name of an individual student or any other
9 identifying information.**

10 **2. Any school district or school that has adopted a year-round school calendar shall
11 provide the information specified in subsection 1 of this section twice annually at the
12 direction of the department of elementary and secondary education.**

13 **3. The department of elementary and secondary education may specify a format
14 in which the information may be provided.**

15 **4. Each parent, guardian, or other person responsible for a child enrolled in a home
16 school under section 167.031 shall notify the chief school officer of the child's school district**
