### AN ACT

To repeal section 337.503, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to discrimination in promulgation of regulations for certain health care professionals.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 337.503, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 337.503, to read as follows:

337.503. No official, employee, board, commission, county, municipality, school district, agency of the state, or any other political subdivision thereof shall discriminate between persons licensed under sections 337.500 to 337.540 **and persons licensed under chapters 334 and 337** when promulgating regulations or when requiring or recommending services that legally may be performed by persons licensed under sections 337.500 to 337.540, **and by persons licensed under chapters 334 and 337.**
