AN ACT

To amend chapter 217, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to an offender making a false report against an employee of the department of corrections, with a penalty provision.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 217, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 217.387, to read as follows:

217.387. 1. No offender shall make a false report against any employee of the
department by knowingly giving false information to an employee of the department for
the purpose of implicating any employee of the department in a crime.

2. It is a defense to a prosecution under subsection 1 of this section that the offender
retracted the false information before any employee of the department took substantial
action in reliance thereon.

7 3. The offender shall have the burden of injecting the issue of retraction under
8 subsection 2 of this section.

4. Violation of subsection 1 of this section is a class D felony.
