AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a combat action badge license plate.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 301.4008, to read as follows:

301.4008. Any person who has participated in active duty combat action while serving in the United States Army may apply for special motor vehicle license plates for 2 any vehicle such person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight. Any such person shall 4 make application for the special license plates on a form provided by the director of revenue and furnish such proof as a recipient of the combat infantry badge as the director may require. The director shall then issue license plates bearing the words "COMBAT 7 ACTION BADGE" in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE" in a form prescribed by the director, except that such license plates shall be made with fully reflective material, 10 shall have a white background with a blue and red configuration at the discretion of the director, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed 11 12 by section 301.130. Such plates shall also bear an image of the Army combat action badge. 13 There shall be an additional fee charged for each set of special combat action badge license 14 plates issued equal to the fee charged for personalized license plates in section 301.144. There shall be no limit on the number of license plates any person qualified under this 15 16 section may obtain so long as each set of license plates issued under this section is issued for vehicles owned solely or jointly by such person.
