## AN ACT

To repeal section 169.712, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the public education employee retirement system.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 169.712, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 169.712, to read as follows:

169.712. 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person duly certificated under the law governing the certification of teachers in Missouri who, after August 2 3 28, 1997, is first employed in a position which would otherwise qualify the person for 4 membership in the public education employee retirement system pursuant to the provisions of 5 sections 169.600 to 169.710 shall be a member of the public school retirement system pursuant to the provisions of sections 169.010 to 169.141, and shall receive creditable service on a pro rata 6 basis in that system for subsequent certificated services which would otherwise have been 7 8 creditable in the public education employee retirement system. Any such person shall have the 9 option of being a member of the public education employee retirement system. The option 10 election must be filed with the board of trustees of the public school retirement system within 11 ninety days of first such employment following August 28, 1997.

2. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any person duly certificated under the law governing the certification of teachers in Missouri who, on or after August 28, 2003, is employed by a public school, as defined in section 169.010, for at least seventeen but less than twenty hours per week on a regular basis shall be a member of the public school retirement system pursuant to the provisions of sections 169.010 to 169.141, and shall receive creditable service on a pro rata basis in that system. Any such person shall have the option of

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18 being a member of the public education employee retirement system. The option election must

19 be filed with the board of trustees of the public school retirement system within ninety days of

20 first such employment or within ninety days of August 28, 2003, whichever later occurs.

21 Beginning August 28, 2010, any person employed by a public school for seventeen hours

22 or less per week may be employed by another public school. Such hours shall not be

cumulative for any person employed by two or more public schools for purposes of
establishing eligibility for creditable service in the public school retirement system unless
specifically approved by the board of trustees of the public school retirement system.

26 3. Any person who is a member of the public school retirement system or the public 27 education employee retirement system pursuant to subsection 2 of this section may purchase 28 credit in such system for service after August 28, 1991, that would have qualified such person 29 for membership in either retirement system pursuant to subsection 2 of this section had such subsection been in effect prior to August 28, 2003; provided that such purchase of credit in the 30 31 public school retirement system shall be subject to the provisions of section 169.056 and such purchase of credit in the public education employee retirement system shall be subject to the 32 33 provisions of section 169.655.

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
