limited to a sunlamp, tanning booth or ta	anning bed;
(2) "Tanning facility", any loca	tion, place, area, structure, or business which provides persons
access to any tanning device for a fee, m	nembership dues, or any other form of compensation.
2. Prior to any person less than	eighteen years of age using a tanning device in a tanning facility,
a parent or guardian of such person shall	l appear in person at the tanning facility and sign a written
statement acknowledging that the parent	t or guardian has read and understands the warnings given by the
tanning facility and consents to the person	on's use of a tanning device at the tanning facility.
3. The department of health and	d senior services shall, by rule, develop a standard consent form to
be used by all tanning facilities operating	g in this state. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is
defined in section 536.010, that is create	ed under the authority delegated in this section shall become
effective only if it complies with and is	subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable,
section 536.028. This section and chapt	eer 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the
general assembly pursuant to chapter 53	6 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul
a rule are subsequently held unconstituti	ional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed
or adopted after August 28, 2011, shall b	be invalid and void.
4. Any person who violates the	provisions of this section is guilty of a class C misdemeanor. Any
tanning facility that violates the provision	ons of this section shall be subject to a fine of one thousand dollars
for each violation. Every use of a tannir	ng device in a tanning facility in violation of this section is a
separate offense.

resources of law enforcement and the de	epartment of health and senior services."; and
