corporate and politic.	
2. The commission shall consist of the g	governor, lieutenant governor, the state treasurer, the state
attorney general, and six members to be selected	by the governor, with the advice and consent of the
senate. The persons to be selected by the govern	nor shall be individuals knowledgeable in the areas of
housing, finance or construction. Not more than	n four of the members appointed by the governor shall be
from the same political party. The members of t	the commission appointed by the governor shall serve the
following terms: Two shall serve two years, two	o shall serve three years, and two shall serve four years,
respectively. Thereafter, each appointment shall	l be for a term of four years. If for any reason a vacancy
occurs, the governor, with the advice and conser	nt of the senate, shall appoint a new member to fill the
unexpired term. Members are eligible for reappo	pintment.
3. Six members of the commission shall	l constitute a quorum. No vacancy in the membership of
the commission shall impair the right of a quoru	m to exercise all the rights and perform all the duties of
the commission. No action shall be taken by the	e commission except upon the affirmative vote of at least
six of the members of the commission.	
4. Each member of the commission app	pointed by the governor is entitled to compensation of fifty
dollars per diem plus his reasonable and necessa	ary expenses actually incurred in discharging his duties
under sections 215.010 to 215.250.	
5. The department staff shall report to a	an executive director who shall be appointed by the
governor and such executive director shall imple	ement only those policies which are presented by the
executive director and approved by the commiss	sion.
6. The employment of the executive dir	rector, including the executive director serving in such
capacity on the effective date of this section, sha	all be subject to the advice and consent of the senate in the
same manner as an appointment subject to the pr	rovisions of article IV, section 51 of the Missouri
Constitution and shall be for a term of three year	rs subject to reappointment for additional terms. Each
additional term shall be subject to the advice and	d consent of the senate."; and
