SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 5Offered by Ridgway of ClayAmend SS/SCS/HCS/House Bill Nos. 73 & 47, Page 2, Section 208.027, Line 8,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "2. Case workers of applicants or recipients shall be  
4 required to ~~report~~ report or cause a report to be made to  
5 the children's division in accordance with the provisions of  
6 sections 210.109 to 210.183 for suspected child abuse as a result  
7 of drug abuse in instances where the case worker has knowledge  
8 that:

9 (1) An applicant or recipient has tested positive for the  
10 illegal use of a controlled substance; or

11 (2) An applicant or recipient has refused to be tested for  
12 the illegal use of a controlled substance.

13 3. Other members of a household which includes a person who  
14 has been declared ineligible for temporary assistance for needy  
15 families assistance shall, if otherwise eligible, continue to  
16 receive temporary assistance for needy families benefits as  
17 protective or vendor payments to a third-party payee for the  
18 benefit of the members of the household."; and

19 Further renumber the remaining subsection accordingly.

SENATE AMENDMENT NO. 6Offered by Justus of 10thAmend SS/SCS/HCS/ House Bill Nos. 73 & 47, Page 2, Section 208.027, Line 3,

2 by inserting after the word "decision" the following:

3 "unless such applicant or recipient, after having been  
4 referred by the department, enters and successfully completes a  
5 substance abuse treatment program and does not test positive for  
6 illegal use of a controlled substance in the six-month period  
7 beginning on the date of entry into such rehabilitation or  
8 treatment program. The applicant or recipient shall continue to  
9 receive benefits while participating in the treatment program.  
10 The department may test the applicant or recipient for illegal  
11 drug use at random or set intervals, at the department's  
12 discretion, after such period. If the applicant or recipient  
13 tests positive for the use of illegal drugs a second time, then  
14 <sup>applicant or</sup> such recipient shall be declared ineligible for temporary  
15 assistance for needy families benefits for a period of three  
16 years from the date of the administrative hearing decision".
